You must be a student in good standing (minimum of 2.5 GPA, attendance, etc..)

You must exemplify the qualities of a good citizen and be involved in civic and school related activities.

Evidence of college acceptance will be required prior to disbursement of funds.

3. Typed resume to include school activities and community service
(Include contact name and number)
4. High School transcript
5. References from

 - b) Community organization leader (not a family member)
